Guidelines for Establishing Scholarships for International Students upon Enrollment at National Chin-Yi University of Technology

- I. The Scholarships are established for the purposes of facilitating international education and enrolling international students at National Chin-Yi University of Technology (the "University") with excellent academic standing, and encouraging them to pursue their studies.
- II. Subjects: New international students (excluding students from the International Bachelor Program, Hong Kong, Macau, and Mainland China, as well as overseas Chinese students and exchange students) who are officially enrolled in the University and who have not received government scholarships.

III. Mode:

- (1) Free tuition and miscellaneous fees for the first and second year for doctoral students studying at the University; free tuition and miscellaneous fees for the first year of international students; free tuition and miscellaneous fees for the first semester of other international pre-graduate students studying at the University.
- (2) Graduate students who have enrolled and completed their registration from the second semester of the 2021 academic year (inclusive) may receive an additional NT\$5,000 scholarship per semester (for up to four semesters; subject to two semesters for other international pre-graduate students).
- IV. Application process: After international students have completed enrollment, the Office of International Affairs will make a list and work with the Offices of Student Affairs to submit it to the President for approval.
- V. Those who have already been awarded a scholarship under the Guidelines are not eligible to apply for other similar scholarship at the University. Qualification will be canceled if enrollment is not completed, maintained, or is suspended before enrollment. Students may not re-apply for a scholarship if they re-enroll after suspension.
- VI. Funding sources: Scholarships are awarded from the University Student Financial Aid Fund.
- VII. The "Evaluation Committee of International Students' Scholarship and Financial Aid" has been set up to review scholarship applications from international students. It comprises five people selected by the President from members of the University Student Financial Aid Committee, one of whom is elected as the convener of the Committee.
- VIII. The Guidelines enter into effect from the date of promulgation following ratification by the University Student Financial Aid Committee. The same shall apply to all future amendments.
