- I. The Scholarships are established for the purposes of facilitating international education, recruiting National Chin-Yi University of Technology (hereinafter referred to as “University”) international students with excellent academic standing, and encouraging them to pursue study diligently.
- II. Object: New international students (excluding students from IBPIUC and International Bachelor Program, Hong Kong, Macau and Mainland Chinese, as well as overseas Chinese students and exchange students) who are officially enrolled in the University and are not entitled to any scholarships and financial assistance granted by authorities in Taiwan are eligible for applying for the scholarships.
- III. Mode:
 1. Free tuition and miscellaneous fees for the first and second year for doctoral students studying in the University; free tuition and miscellaneous fees for the first year for other international students studying in the University.
 2. Graduate students who have enrolled and completed their registration from the second semester of 2021 academic year (included) may receive an additional NT\$5,000 scholarship per semester (for up to four semesters).
- IV. Application process: After international students have completed enrollment, Office of International Affairs will make a list uniformly and work with Office of Academic Affairs and Office of Student Affairs to submit it to the President for approval.
- V. Those who have already been awarded the scholarship under the Guidelines are not eligible to apply for other similar scholarships in the University. Qualification will be canceled if enrollment is not completed, maintained, or is suspended before enrollment. Re-applying for the scholarship is not allowed for those who have re-enrolled after suspension.
- VI. Funding sources: The scholarships will be awarded from the University Student Financial Aid Fund.
- VII. The “Evaluation Committee of International Students’ Financial Aid” is set for reviewing scholarship applications from international students. It is comprised of five persons selected by the President from the University Student Financial Aid Committee, of which one is elected the head of the Committee.
- VIII. The Guidelines are entered into effect from the date of promulgation following the ratification by the University Student Financial Aid Committee. The same shall apply to all its amendments.
